

Poster Presentation Guidelines

Introduction

The Congress Committee thanks you for agreeing to present at the upcoming 13th APVRS Congress in Shanghai, China. This document has been prepared to assist you with planning a successful presentation for APVRS 2019.

Registration

All poster presenters must register and pay the applicable registration fees to remain in the program. Presenters who fail to pay registration fees risk being removed from the program at the discretion of the Program Committee. There is no reduced registration fee for presenters. Please go to the Registration page on the Congress website at http://congress.apvrs.org/.

The APVRS 2019 Congress registration desk is located on the 2/F, Hall 4.2 of National Exhibition and Convention Center (NECC) and will operate during the following hours:

- All presenters can prepare an audio recording (if any, maximum length: 3 minutes) to accompany their poster presentations. The recording should be uploaded to the APVRS
 Congress system at <u>http://congress.apvrs.org</u> by 11:59pm (GMT+8) on November 4, 2019.
- A QR code, which will be printed on each poster, can be downloaded from the Congress system with an accompanying recording. When the QR code is scanned, viewers will be directed to a link where they can hear the recording prepared by the poster presenter.
